

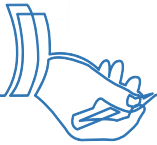

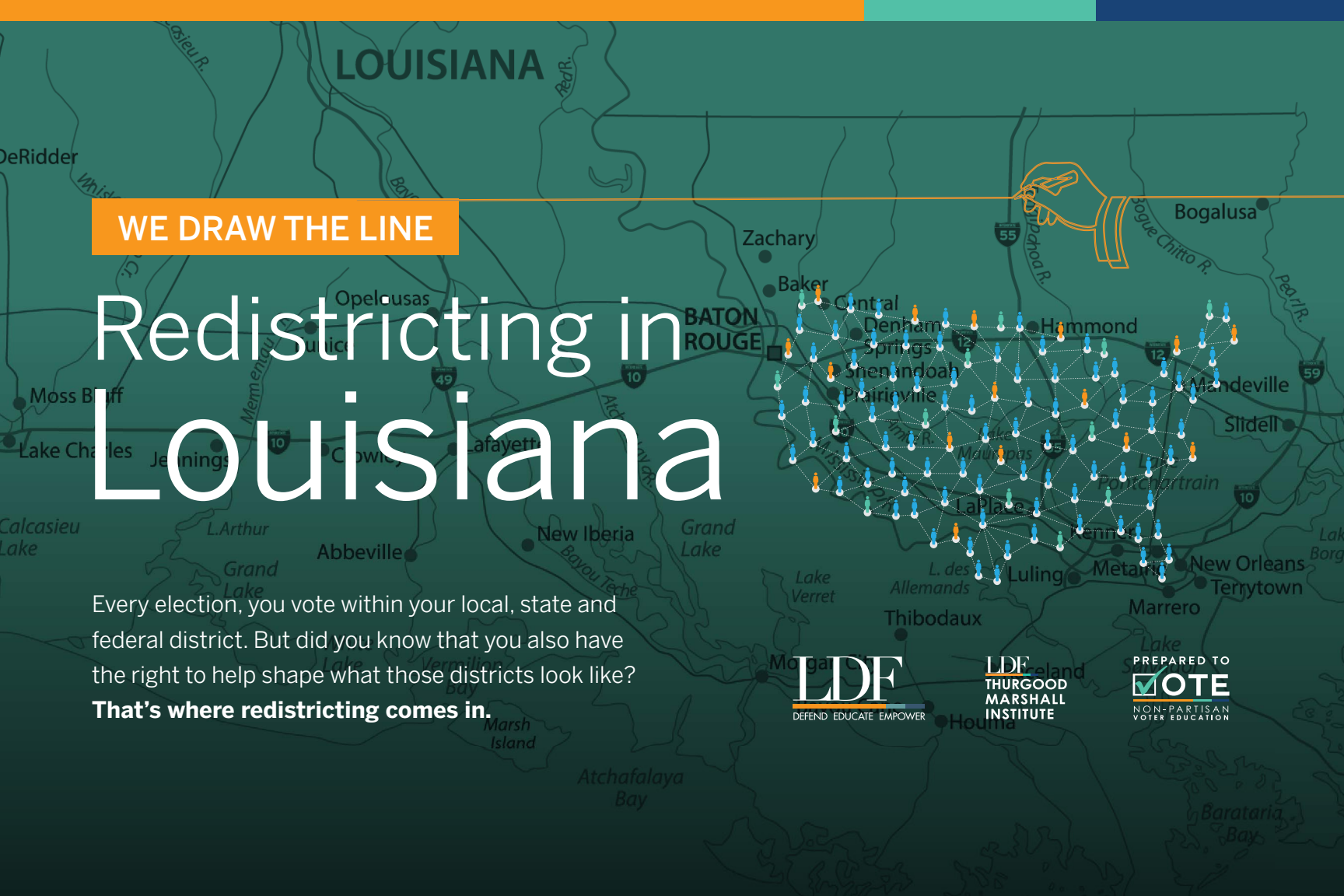
Every election, you vote within your local, state and federal district. But did you know that you also have the right to help shape what those districts look like?
